NOTICE is hereby given of a meeting of the City Council of the City of El Lago, County of Harris, State of Texas, to be held on the above stated date and time at: City Hall Events Room, 411 Tallowood Drive, El Lago, Texas, for the purpose of considering the following numbered items.

- 3. Disinfect hands upon entering the building and after any interaction with others in the building.*
- 4. Wear cloth face coverings (over the nose and mouth) when entering the building per the order of Harris County Judge Hidalgo*

MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 16, 2020 REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING BY TELECONFERENCE 411 TALLOWOOD DRIVE, EL LAGO, TEXAS 77586

1. **Call to Order** Mayor Skelton called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

2. **Declaration of a Quorum**

Present: Mayor John Skelton
Councilperson Shawn Findley
Mayor Pro Tem Ann Vernon
Councilperson Darin Clark
Councilperson Jeff Michalak
Councilperson Kris Kuehnel

3. **Citizen Comments** -The following Citizen Comments were read aloud by City Secretary, Rachel Lewis as they were submitted.

Joe Neight of 443 Shadow Creek Drive – “As the HOA President for Sections 1-4, I have recently been noticing more problem areas in our neighborhood, as well as many significant violations of the parking code. I documented these violations in a very small section of our city for a month to characterize the problem, and I e-mailed this report to you yesterday. As a quick summary of my report, I typically saw 2-3 significant parking violations each time I walked a block or two. I am asking for your help. I briefed the LVPD Police Commission this week on this same problem. During the police commission meeting, several areas were identified in terms of Code Violations in regards to reporting and communication, that is a positive and welcome step. I did not get a response regarding the parking violations, as it was introduced during Citizens Comments, but I hope I will in the near term. It is not my goal to have citizens issued tickets that they must pay, rather remind citizens that ordinances on the books to keep our city looking its best and maintaining and increasing our property values. This can be done through warnings and education. The HOAs, City Government, and LVPD must all be working for the same, common good. These violations in my report were not a problem 4-5 years ago, and at that time they were immediately addressed by the police on patrol. Is there a reason that we no longer regularly and routinely enforce these ordinances?”

Jeff Tave of 302 Pine View Circle – “City Council, please vote against Resolution 2020-08 authorizing the city to enter into the documented marketing agreement which would allow the marketing company to use city logos and letterhead to sell water/sewer line warranty & repair services. Unless the city is willing to research ALL entities and contractors (including 3rd party subcontractors) to ensure quality service and minimal to no customer complaints with work performed, then the agreement puts the city at risk for representing substandard companies and/or contractors. I think the City has higher priority items to work rather than getting involved with something that could involve the city in potentially problematic transactions due to substandard work quality.”

Mayor Skelton responded to the comments stating he agreed that parking violations should be enforced and that the City and the police department should work together. He stated the police are present to enforce the laws rather than to train but Chief Savage could comment more later in the meeting about this. Regarding Resolution 2020-08, the Mayor stated that there is no indication that substandard companies were involved and the program is endorsed by the National League of Cities, however this would also be addressed in more detail later in the meeting.

4. **Consent Agenda City Official, Board, Commission, Committee, & City Service Report**

- 4.1. *Check Detail for checks printed from September 3, 2020 through September 16, 2020.*
- 4.2. *Minutes from the Council Meeting of September 2, 2020.*

Councilperson Findley made a motion to approve and Councilperson Michalak provided a second. Councilpersons Findley, Michalak, Kuehnel, and Clark voted to approve by a roll call vote, and Mayor Pro Tem Vernon abstained. The motion passed.

5. **City Official, Board, Commission, Committee, & City Service Report**

- 5.1. *Report on LPD activity in the City with Call For Service reports for July, 2020* – Chief Tom Savage presented the Call for Service report for July, 2020. Mayor Pro Tem Vernon questioned the number of

suspicious activity calls and Chief Savage said that this is a normal number. Chief Savage stated that he agreed with citizen Joe Neigut regarding his concern about the parking violations and asked Council about the enforcement of the ordinance when residents park on the grass. He stated sometimes there is just a tire on the grass beside the driveway. He said his plan is to have warnings issued but if it happens habitually then citations would be issued.

- 5.2. *City Secretary to introduce Cheryl Hunter who was chosen to fill the open part-time Administrative Assistant position with the City* – City Secretary, Rachel Lewis, introduced Cheryl Hunter to Council. Ms. Hunter has almost 30 years of experience in government finance and is a Certified Public Accountant. She was selected to fill the open part-time position of Administrative Assistant and began work for the City on August 10, 2020.

6. Council Reports

- 6.1. *Councilperson Michalak to report on a recommended public awareness committee regarding adherence to the City leash laws* – Councilperson Michalak reported that the committee met last week and Chief Savage explained the process for handling loose animals within the city. The committee is still working on a communications campaign and the plan is to begin with the City website and then use social media followed by mailers. He stated that resident Tiffany Wallace is developing the content for this campaign.

7. Old Business

- 7.1. *Consider/Approve Resolution 2020-08 authorizing the City to enter into an agreement with the National League of Cities to advertise to the City's residents of warranty plans for repairs of external water lines, external sewer lines, and in home plumbing on residential property.* Dan Dansby was present to answer any questions regarding the program. He explained that his agency is Home Serve which is a for-profit company endorsed by the National League of Cities. He said that the National League of Cities approached them to offer this program and vetted his company along with other companies they were considering. The National League of Cities receives no financial benefit from endorsing the program. He explained that Resolution 2020-08 states that there would be a three year agreement however, this could be reduced to one year if that's what the City would like to do. City Secretary Lewis explained that the resolution was reviewed by the City Attorney but the contract has not yet been reviewed. No motion was made so no action was considered.

8. New Business

- 8.1. *Consider/Approve newly hired Police Officer Corrie Moody with the Lakeview Police Department.* Chief Savage went over Officer Corrie Moody's background with Council and stated that she was hired as the extra officer but would replace David Sullivan when he retires soon. Mayor Pro Tem Vernon made a motion to approve and there was a second from Councilperson Clark. The motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote.
- 8.2. *Consider/Approve proposed 2020 Maintenance and Operations Ad Valorem no-new-revenue tax rate of \$0.431542 per \$100 valuation and proposed 2020 Debt rate of \$.053877 per \$100 valuation for a total 2020 proposed ad valorem tax rate of \$0.485419 per \$100 valuation.* Cheryl Hunter explained the tax rate to Council and the rate changed slightly when the certified rolls were received from the Harris County Appraisal District. Mayor Pro Tem Vernon made a motion to approve and Councilperson Michalak provided a second. The vote to approve was as follows:

Councilperson Michalak – “Aye”
Councilperson Clark – “Aye”
Councilperson Kuehnel – “Aye”
Councilperson Vernon – “Aye”
The motion passed unanimously.
- 8.3. *Consider/Approve proposed FY2021 budget with a total income of \$2,132,327.05, maintenance and operations expenses of \$2,019,085.83, debt expense of \$150,933.00, and monies from reserved funds of \$37,691.78 to support the budget.* City Secretary Lewis explained some changes to the previously approved proposed budget. Mayor Skelton stated that there is an additional expense of \$1800 for floodplain inspections and he has a plan to include a fee for floodplain inspections which will be discussed with Council soon. Mayor Pro Tem Vernon stated there are \$39,230 in METRO funds that will not be expended this fiscal year because the water district asked that the City wait on these repairs. They have a \$2 million project beginning next year to increase pipe sizes in several areas in the City. She

requested that the \$39,230 be added to this budget. Councilperson Michalak asked about any increase in solid waste costs due to discontinuing curbside recycling. City Secretary Lewis stated she contacted AmeriWaste and was told that there will be no added costs. Additionally, she was told that residents can contact AmeriWaste to set-up their own curbside recycling accounts individually. Mayor Pro Tem Vernon made a motion to approve a total budget of \$2,170,718.83, with maintenance and operations expenses of \$2,059,015.83, and debt expense of \$150,933.00. This budget is bolstered by incomes plus \$76,921.78 from other accounts including reserve, METRO, PEG, Child Safety, and Building Security. Councilperson Findley seconded. The vote was as follows:

Councilperson Vernon – “Aye”

The vote was unanimous to approve.

- 8.4. *Consider/Approve Resolution 2020-09 declaring City cell phones as surplus property and authorizing the City Secretary to execute sale or dispose of said property.* City Secretary Lewis explained that the City cell phones are no longer in use and she would like to sell them as surplus property. Councilperson Michalak made a motion to approve with a second from Mayor Pro Tem Vernon. The vote by roll call was unanimous to approve.

9. Future Agenda Items

Mayor Pro Tem Vernon stated that she will look into proposing a No Solicitation ordinance for the next meeting and would also look into a communications campaign for the City. Mayor Skelton stated he planned to present a plan for floodplain inspection fees. He also plans to schedule an Executive Session for the next meeting to discuss city employee salaries.

10. **Adjournment** – There being no further business the Mayor adjourned the meeting at 8:42 PM.

ORDINANCE NO. 470

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EL LAGO, TEXAS LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2020 FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF EL LAGO, TEXAS, SPECIFYING SEPARATE COMPONENTS OF SUCH RATE FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS AND FOR DEBT SERVICE; AND ACCEPTING THE CERTIFIED AND UNCERTIFIED APPRAISED VALUES AS PROVIDED BY THE HARRIS COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT FOR 2020 FOR THE CITY OF EL LAGO.

THE NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE FOR THE 2020 TAX YEAR WILL RAISE THE SAME AMOUNT OF PROPERTY TAX REVENUE FROM THE SAME PROPERTIES IN BOTH THE 2019 TAX YEAR AND THE 2020 TAX YEAR.

WHEREAS, the City of El Lago's Tax Assessor has submitted the appraisal roll for the City with a total appraised value of \$278,692,164; and

WHEREAS, the following notice in accordance with applicable legal requirements and based upon said appraisal roll, the City Council has determined a tax rate to be levied for 2020 sufficient to provide the tax revenues in support of the fiscal year 2021 budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL LAGO, TEXAS:

Section 1. That an ad valorem tax rate of four hundred eighty-five thousand four hundred and nineteen millionths (\$0.485419) on each one hundred dollars (\$100) assessed valuation of property which represents 100 percent (100%) of the appraised value and with such rate consisting of the following specified components:

- a) Four hundred thirty-one thousand five hundred and forty-two millionths (\$0.431542) cents on each one hundred dollars (\$100) assessed valuation shall be designated for the support of city operations and maintenance; and
- b) Fifty-three thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven millionths (\$0.053877) cents on each one hundred dollars (\$100) assessed valuation shall be designated for debt service,

Section 2. That an ad valorem tax for the 2020 calendar year in the amount established by the rate hereinabove provided is hereby levied and shall be collected upon all property, real, personal, and mixed situated within the corporate limits of the City of El Lago, Texas subject to taxation as of January 1, 2020, and not otherwise exempt under the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas.

Section 3. The certified taxable value of \$252,555,308 plus an uncertified estimated taxable value of \$30,183,489 for a total estimated appraised value of \$282,738,797 by the Harris County Appraisal District on the appraisal roll dated September 4, 2020, is hereby accepted.

Section 4. The tax herein levied shall be deposited in the General Fund of the City of El Lago, Texas, and a record kept of same.

Section 5. All monies collected under this ordinance for city operations and maintenance are hereby appropriated to the General Fund of the City of El Lago, Texas. The City Secretary shall keep account of such funds to readily and distinctly show the amount collected, the amounts expended and for what purpose and the amount on hand at any time.

Section 6. SEVERABILITY

If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance, or any amendment thereof, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid, the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or sets of circumstance shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of City Council in adopting this ordinance that no portion thereof, or regulation contained here, shall become inoperative or fail by reason of the unconstitutionality of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable for that purpose.

ORDINANCE NO. 471
