HELD ON APRIL 13, 2020**

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Commissioner Delly asked how the department is dealing with current COVID-19 circumstances. Chief Savage informed commissioners it has been one step at a time. Both cities did their lock downs first then after a family disturbance spilled over into the PD lobby, it was decided to lock down the PD. The Office gets a wipe down daily. Officers were e-mailed memos about safe distancing, and requirements to wear masks. Harris County relays addresses of self-quarantines that are then flagged in the computer system to make officers aware. The information is also forwarded to the mayors.
