Old Business:

Spoke with Daryl about the boards that were rotted through on the Gazebo at Armstrong Park. They have been replaced.

Ruth and Shirley spoke about the dead trees in Armstrong park and 98 Lakeshore that need to be removed.

WE all agree the entrances need a lot of help and that parts of the Lakeshore Entrance is falling down.

Whitty Park Needs:

The small house needs repainted, replace some floor boards, reinforce the table in the house.

Alligator put into the park.

The fountain is still not working

Crape Myrtle needs trimming by the street close to the water cut off.

Whitty Park sign has some damage on the sides of the sign.

McNair Park: The bridge needs to be repaired and stained.

Rob went and looked at the fence line by the duplex it looks ok but a dead Christmas tree is setting there.

The mesquite tree still needs to come down

The new water fountain has a lot of rust around it. When we meet in the park with Daryl about the Lending Library we will talk to him about that.
